PALM COAST YACHT CLUB AT HELM OF BLESSING OF THE FLEET FOR COUNTY BOATERS

Palm Coast, Florida, March 21, 2019 – Palm Coast’s traditional Blessing of the Fleet returns to the city once again under the auspices of the Palm Coast Yacht Club on Saturday, April 13, 2019, at 3:00 p.m.

The blessing is open to all vessels, motorized or non-motorized, large or small. The blessing will take place at Yacht Harbor Village and will be administered by Father Robert Goolsby, rector of St. Thomas Episcopal Church of Palm Coast. Father Goolsby will be stationed on the long pier of Yacht Harbor Village on the east side of the Intracoastal Waterway just north of the Hammock Dunes Bridge.

Boats will gather on the ICW at 2:40 p.m. south of the Hammock Dunes Bridge. Captains are asked to monitor Channel 68 for instructions. The Palm Coast Yacht Club website, www.palmcoastyachtclub.com, will provide information on event status in case of inclement weather.

The Palm Coast Yacht Club was established in 1979 and continues to welcome new members every month. The Club’s many activities include fundraisers for local charities; the Club also manages the annual Palm Coast Holiday Boat Parade, the largest in Central Florida.
